## WARSAW UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY Regulation No. 189/2020 of the WUT Rector of 10 September 2020

on the launch of the Scholarship+ Programme at WUT as part of the implementation of the project "Excellence Initiative – Research University" at WUT

Under article 23 section 1, pursuant to article 389, sections 1 and 2 of the Law on Higher Education and Science of 20 July 2018 (Journal of Laws of 2020 item 85, including amendments) and in connection with the Agreement No. 04/IDUB/2019/94 of 30 December 2019 signed between the State Treasury represented by the Minister of Science and Higher Education and the Warsaw University of Technology, it is resolved as follows:

The Scholarship+ Programme at WUT, implemented in accordance with the Regulations constituting an Appendix to this Regulation, is launched as part of the implementation of the project "Excellence Initiative – Research University" at WUT.

Regulation No. 167/2020 of the WUT Rector of 31 July 2020 on the launch of the Scholarship+ Programme at WUT as part of the implementation of the project "Excellence Initiative – Research University" at WUT shall expire.

## The Scholarship+ Programme Regulations at WUT

§1

The purpose of the Scholarship+ Programme at WUT, further referred to as the "Programme", is to raise above the minimum the amount of grant awarded to doctoral students of doctoral schools at the Warsaw University of Technology, specified in the Law on Higher Education and Science of 20 July 2018, further referred to as the "Law". The Programme is implemented as part of and funded by the project "Excellence Initiative – Research University", further referred to as the "Project IDUB (IDUB – Inicjatywa Doskonałości – Uczelnia Badawcza)", implemented at the Warsaw University of Technology under article 389 sections 1 and 2 of the Law.

<u></u>§2

- 1. Beneficiaries of the Programme shall be the students of doctoral studies at the Warsaw University of Technology in the course of the implementation of the Programme and receiving grants specified by the Law, excluding implementation doctorates.
- 2. Beneficiaries of the Programme shall receive Scholarship+ from 1 October 2020.
- 3. Scholarship+ is awarded for 12 months, excluding doctoral students recruited in summer semester of the academic year 2019/2020, who shall be awarded Scholarship+ for the first year of study from October 2020 to February 2021.
- 4. Scholarship+ is awarded every year upon the doctoral student's request submitted to the Head of Management Team of IDUB Programme via Department of Doctoral Student Service, further referred to as DOD (DOD Dział Obsługi Doktorantów), in accordance with the specimen of an application constituting an Appendix to these Regulations, after the recruitment or registration for the next year of study, respectively, in accordance with the lists of admitted or registered students submitted to DOD by heads of WUT doctoral schools.
- 5. The application mentioned in section 4 shall be submitted no later than 7 days after the commencement of the academic year or the summer semester, in the case of doctoral students who commenced their study in the summer semester, subject to section 6.
- 6. Doctoral students admitted to doctoral schools in February 2020 submit the application mentioned in section 4 no later than 7 days after the commencement of the academic year 2020/2021.
- 7. Regulations on doctoral grants shall apply to Scholarship+.

§3

- 1. The amount of Scholarship+ depends on the year of study of a doctoral student and on fulfilling an academic criterion associated with the Project IDUB indices.
- 2. The academic criterion includes being a co-author of a scientific publication listed in TOP10, in compliance with a list published on <u>www.badawcza.pw.edu.pl</u>, or being a co-author of an international publication (with internationally affiliated co-authors) published within 12 months before the date of the submission of the application.
- 3. The amounts of Scholarship+ awarded in the Programme are as follows:

All matters concerning Scholarship+ not regulated herein shall be settled by the Prorector specific for the supervision on the implementation of the Project IDUB in agreement with the Prorector specific for doctoral students.
