Decision No. 65/2026
of the Rector of the Warsaw University of Technology
of 1.04.2026

on relaunching the Grant+ Programme at WUT as part of the implementation of the “Excellence Initiative – Research University” project at the Warsaw University of Technology

Pursuant to Article 23 section 1, in connection with Article 389 section 1 and 2 of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2024 item 1571, as amended) and in connection with the Agreement No. 04/IDUB/2019/94 30 December 2019 concluded between the State Treasury represented by the Minister of Science and Higher Education, and the Warsaw University of Technology, it is resolved as follows:

§ 1

As part of the implementation of the “Excellence Initiative – Research University” project at the Warsaw University of Technology, the Grant+ Programme shall be relaunched at WUT, and shall be implemented in compliance with the Regulations annexed to this Decision.

§ 2

Decision No. 189/2020 of the Rector of the Warsaw University of Technology of 10 September 2020 on the launch of the Grant+ Programme at WUT as part of the implementation of the “Excellence Initiative – Research University” project at the Warsaw University of Technology shall expire.

§ 3

The Decision enters into force upon signing.

Regulations for the Grant+ Programme at WUT

§ 1

The aim of the Grant+ Programme at WUT, hereinafter referred to as the “Programme”, is to raise the amount of grant above the minimum specified in the Act “Law on Higher Education and Science” of 20 July 2018, hereinafter referred to as the “Law”, and awarded to PhD students of the doctoral schools at the Warsaw University of Technology that show outstanding academic achievements. The Programme is implemented as part of and funded by the project “Excellence Initiative – Research University”, hereinafter referred to as the “IDUB Project (IDUB – Inicjatywa Doskonałości – Uczelnia Badawcza)”, implemented at the Warsaw University of Technology under Article 389 sections 1 and 2 of the Law.

§ 2

1. Beneficiaries of the Programme shall be PhD students of the Doctoral School at the Warsaw University of Technology in the course of the implementation of the Programme and receiving grants specified by the Law, excluding those conducting implementation doctorates.
2. The Grant+ is awarded from 1 March 2026 to 31 December 2026, subject to section 5.
3. The Grant+ is awarded following the doctoral student’s application submitted to the Head of Management Team for the IDUB Programme via the WUT Doctoral School, hereinafter referred to as “SDPW”, in compliance with the template annexed to the Regulations. The WUT Doctoral School shall confirm the PhD student’s status.
4. The application mentioned in section 3 shall be submitted no later than 14 days after the announcement of this Decision. For PhD students commencing their studies at the Warsaw University of Technology Doctoral School in October 2026, the application shall be submitted within 14 days of the student’s enrolment on the admissions list.
5. If an application is submitted after the deadline specified in section 4, the duration of the awarded grant shall be shortened and shall begin in the month following the month in which the application is submitted. The submitted application may not be updated with regard to the academic criterion.
6. Regulations on doctoral grants shall apply to Grant+.

§ 3

1. The amount of Grant+ shall depend on the fulfilment of the academic criterion.
2. The academic criterion specified in section 1 includes:
 - 1) articles published in the TOP10 list of journals (based on the list published at www.badawcza.pw.edu.pl), whose co-authors are affiliated with institutions abroad;
 - 2) scientific monographs published by Level II publishers (200 points) according to the current lists of MNiSW;
 - 3) articles published in the TOP10 list of journals (based on the list published at www.badawcza.pw.edu.pl.) whose co-authors are not affiliated with institutions abroad;
 - 4) articles published in the TOP25 list of journals (based on the list published at www.badawcza.pw.edu.pl.) whose co-authors are affiliated with institutions abroad;
 - 5) full-text conference papers published in the conference materials for 200 points according to current lists of MNiSW.
3. The publications referred to in section 2 shall be eligible for inclusion in the academic criterion, provided that:
 - 1) They were published within 12 months before submitting the application.

- 2) They are registered in the university's repository WUT Base of Knowledge.
 - 3) They are affiliated with the Warsaw University of Technology.
 - 4) For publications written after the beginning of education at SDPW – an authorisation issued by the Warsaw University of Technology to list the publication as an achievement in the declaration for evaluative purposes referred to in Article 265 section 13 of the Act – Law on Higher Education and Science.
4. Two thresholds for the academic criterion are set:
- 1) Threshold 1 – for publications fulfilling the provision specified in section 2, items 3, 4, or 5.
 - 2) Threshold 2 – for publications fulfilling the provision specified in section 2, items 1 or 2.
5. The amounts of Grant+ awarded in the Programme are as follows:

Academic criterion	Amount
Threshold 1	PLN 1 200
Threshold 2	PLN 1 700

§ 4

INFORMATION CLAUSE

In accordance with Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (EU OJ L 119/1 of 4 May 2016), hereinafter referred to as “GDPR”, the Warsaw University of Technology hereby informs that:

- 1) The Administrator of your data is the Warsaw University of Technology, with its registered seat at Pl. Politechniki 1, 00-661 Warszawa.
- 2) The Administrator has appointed a Data Protection Officer (Polish: IOD) in his/her field to supervise the correctness of data processing. He or she can be contacted at the following e-mail address: iod@pw.edu.pl.
- 3) The Administrator will process personal data to the extent of the data contained in this agreement.
- 4) The Administrator will process the Doctoral Student's personal data for:
 - The award of the grant under the Grant+ Programme at WUT – the basis for processing data is Article 6, section 1, point a of GDPR.
 - The administration of the Doctoral Student's grant – the basis for processing data is Article 6, section 1, point c of GDPR.
- 5) The Warsaw University of Technology does not intend to transfer your data outside the European Economic Area.
- 6) Doctoral Student will have the right of access to the content of their personal data and the right to correct them, the right to request deletion, restriction of processing, the right to data portability, the right to object to the data processing, and the right to withdraw consent at any time without giving any reason, without affecting the lawfulness of processing conducted based on consent prior to its withdrawal.
- 7) The Doctoral Student's personal data will not be shared with other entities (administrators), except for entities authorised by law.

- 8) The Doctoral Student's personal data may be accessed by entities ("processing entities") to whom Warsaw University of Technology commissions activities that may involve the processing of personal data.
- 9) The Warsaw University of Technology shall not use automated decision-making in relation to the Doctoral Student, including profiling.
- 10) The provision of the Doctoral Student's personal data is voluntary; however, failure to do so will prevent the awarding of funds as part of the GRANT+ PROGRAMME at WUT.
- 11) Doctoral Student's personal data will be processed until the Doctoral Student's consent for personal data processing is revoked and for the purposes of perpetual archiving.
- 12) Doctoral Student has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority - the Polish Data Protection Commissioner - if you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.

§ 5

All matters concerning Grant+ not regulated herein shall be settled by the Vice-Rector responsible for supervising the implementation of the IDUB Project in agreement with the Vice-Rector responsible for doctoral students.
